Description of Program/Training: This comprehensive program prepares students to function as EKG technicians and to take the American Society of Phlebotomy Technician (ASPT) - Electrocardiograph Technician exam, in addition to other national certification exams. This course will include important practice and background information on anatomy of the heart and physiology, medical disease processes, medical terminology, medical ethics, legal aspects of patient contact, the Holter monitor, electrocardiography and echocardiography. Additionally, students will practice with equipment and perform hands-on labs, including introduction to the function and proper use of the EKG machine, the normal anatomy of the chest for proper lead placement, 12-lead placement and other clinical practices. EKG technician also analyze printed readings of EKG tests, measuring various "cardiac intervals and complexes" and determining normal versus abnormal EKG.
