Respondent: City of Beloit Community Development

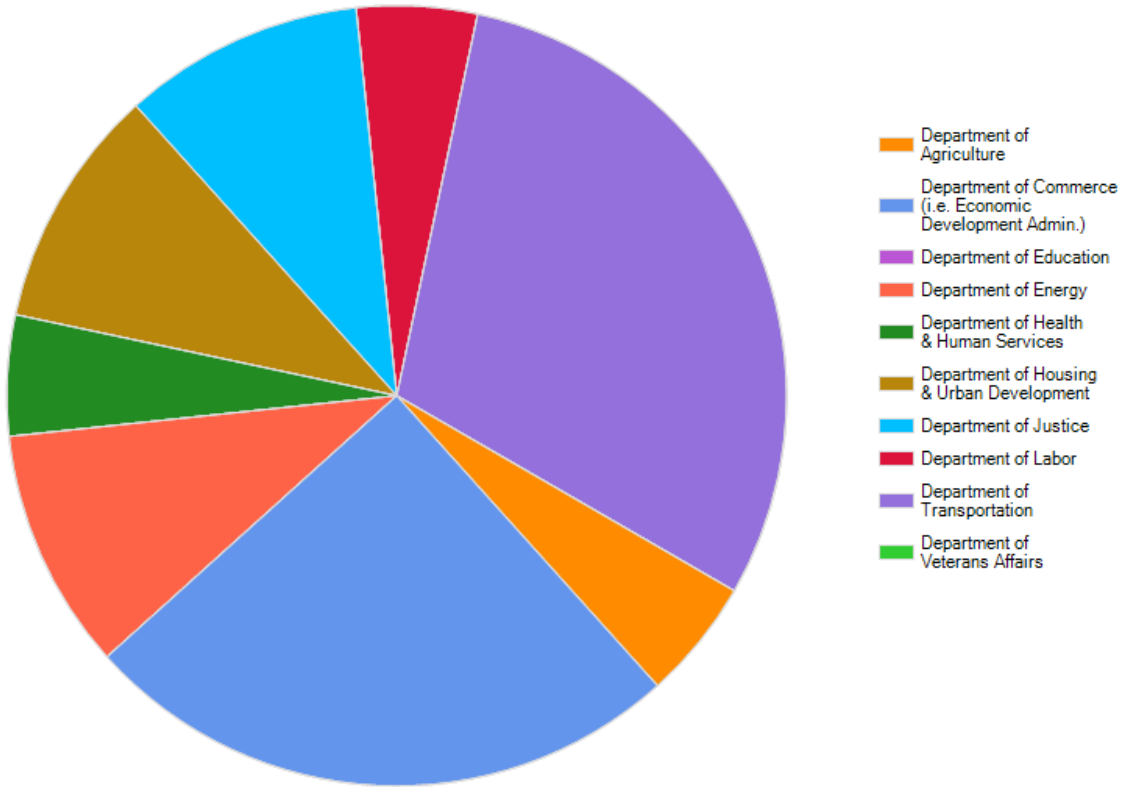
Response: The city has applied for 2010 funding for CDBG, CFP, Section 8 and Public Housing Subsidy.

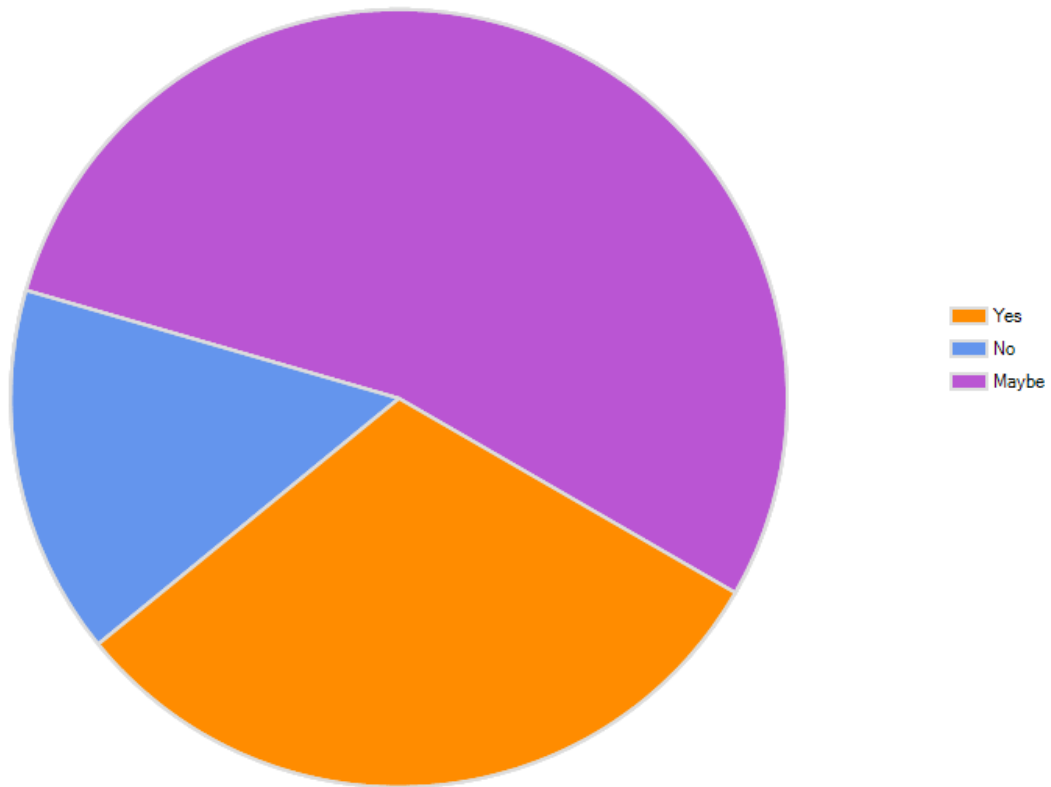
Question 2: Please indicate the source(s) of these grants and/or loans? Mark all that apply.
